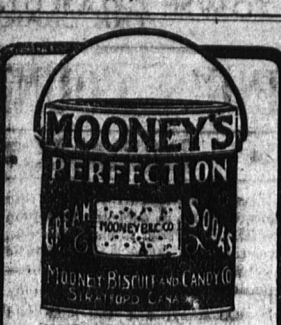

THEY HAVE TO BE "MASTERS IN HOUSE," SAYS BRITISH PREMIER

Prime Minister in a Speech at Plymouth, Declared That the House of Lords Will be Assigned to Their Place.

LONDON, June 10.—Prime Minister Campbell-Bannerman in a speech at Plymouth Friday admitted that the Government was greatly disappointed at their failure to pass the Education and Irish Bills through the House of Lords. "We over-estimated our powers," he said. "Dealing with the conflict with the House of Lords, the Prime Minister, who prefaced his remarks by saying he spoke under a deep sense of responsibility, said:—

RACE WON BY BOY

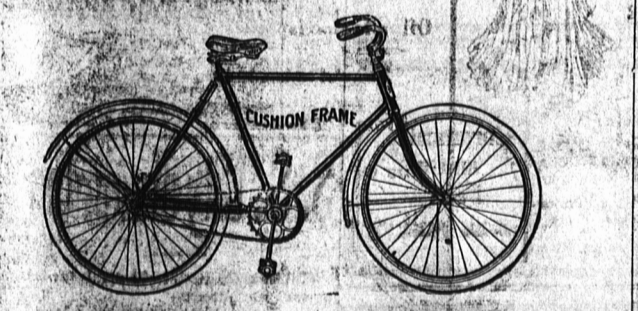
