This horse was bought at the most famous harness horse farm in the world, four world's champion stallions and five of the fastest stallions ever owned on one farm, International Stock Food Farm. This is a very fine horse with everything to make a speedy horse.

Prince Crescus is a show horse. He is very stylish, handsome high finish appearance. He is kind in and out of stable. This stallion is of course a great bred horse, and out of a record mare 2:29, trial as a three year old 2:15. The second dam is in the great brood mare list, the third dam is also a producer of trotters and pacers.

Prince Crescus won first prize at Georgetown last fall. His Colts won first at Georgetown last fall too. Prince was trained a little last fall and could go a 2.24 clip, he is young and well built, strong to go the route. He is not of the long back washey kind that we see too many of.
