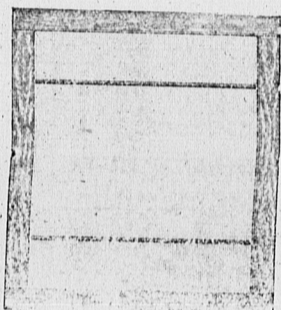

AVIATION COMPANY GRANTED CHARTER.

OTTAWA, June 13--The International Aviation Association, Limited, is the title of a new company to which incorporation has just been granted. Its headquarters will be in Montreal and the capital stock named is \$100,000. This is the first business enterprise of the kind to be incorporated in Canada. The company is empowered to manufacture aeroplanes, balloons and similar devices for travelling in the air, and to hold aviation meets.

Tiptonville, Tenn., June 13--Judge Harris, president of the West Tennessee Land Company, of this city, whose life is said to have been several times threatened by the Reelfoot night riders, was drowned while swimming in Reelfoot Lake near here today.

Harris, with a party of friends, was in a launch on the lake when, to demonstrate his ability as a swimmer, he plunged into the lake. He had swum but a short distance when he threw up his hands and sank. His body was recovered and a post mortem examination showed that death was due to heart failure.

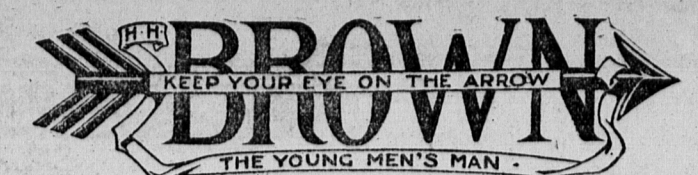

TORONTO METHODIST CONFERENCE AGAINST HIGHER CRITICISM.

TORONTO, June 13--"That the appointment and retention of professors in our theological colleges should be subject to the approval of the general conference, or in interim of a general conference special committee or committee appointed for the purpose."

"It is desirable that all theological professors should be either ministers or members of the Methodist Church in Canada."

On a close vote the Toronto Methodist conference carried the above resolutions Saturday.

An amendment to strike out the words "in Canada," made by Rev. H. Burns, was voted down on a fairly close vote. A further amendment by Dr. A.D. Watson to add the words "where practicable" was voted down by a large majority. The clause suggested as an amendment by Dr. Cleaver was made a separate clause. It read:

"That we memorialize the next general conference to take such action as may be necessary to eliminate from all our theological schools and colleges such teaching concerning the holy scriptures and fallibility of Christ as is contained in Rev. George Jackson's recent book, Studies in the Old Testament."

THE LATEST IN HEAD GEAR.

NEW YORK, June 13--Many queer hats of all sizes are seen in this country, but they have nothing on the one worn by Mrs. Eva Schmidt, who has just arrived from Berlin. She is here as a nurse with a German family, and wears the towering head-dress and costume of Alsacian nurses in their native land.

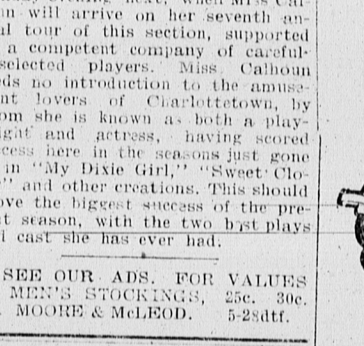
OPERA HOUSE

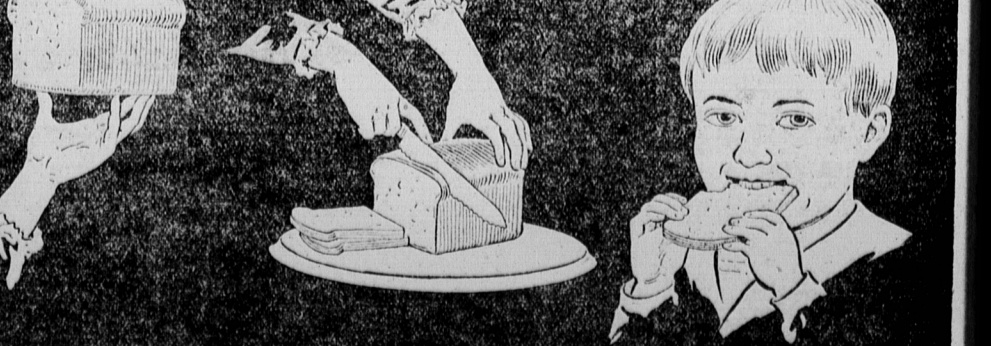
