A NEW EMPIRE

Undeveloped Tract of Land in Northwest Can Support Millions

In the vast basin of the Mackenzie River, the largest river in the world, there lie latent possibilities which may in the future aid in the formation of a new empire. In this immense territory, as yet uncultivated, there are no less than 404,840,000 acres of land which, according to Government reports, are suitable for the production of potatoes, and 202,250,000 acres of the finest wheat land, and these acres will shortly be added to the visible agricultural areas of Canada.

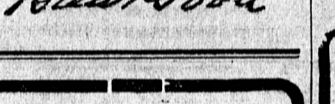
Nearly all minerals of economic value are to be found here, and also platinum, silver, iron, copper, mica, sulphur and saltpetre, while it has a timber area of 200,000 square miles, an illimitable fishing industry, and a fur trade the exact value of which has not been estimated, but which is known to run into millions.

There is also a pastoral area of 860,000 square miles, while its facilities for water transportation are unsurpassed. The Mackenzie River has a navigable mileage of 2,700 miles, and there are 4,000 miles of lake coast. There are, too, immense water powers awaiting development, among them the grand rapids of the Athabasca River, where it is estimated that a 90,000 horsepower can be harnessed.

If all under cultivation the basin of this giant river could produce 8 bushels of wheat, 6 bushels of barley and 60 bushels of potatoes for every man, woman and child on the globe, or in other words, sufficient wheat, barley and potatoes to feed five hundred millions of people.
