**PRUSSIAN MILITARISM MUST FALL BEFORE THE GREAT POWERS**

The following letter written by Edward Christopher, now on active service at the front, has been received by a friend of his in his native village of Tignish. The letter is particularly interesting, as it is written by one who has been on the firing line for months, and who has been fortunate enough to escape, so far, uninjured. Mr. Christopher is a brother of Mrs. Leo Murphy of Tignish. He writes:

Belg. Am. March 24, 1916.

Dear Friend:— Having received your very interesting letter lately, I now grasp this opportunity to answer it. We are doing some very strenuous and hazardous work at night now. It is a common occurrence to be at work and hear heavy German shells whistling over our heads and bursting quite near. They do not seem to be able to get the range as they have missed us so far. We are right in amongst all the Canadians. They seem to be all light-hearted and anxious to get it over.

There is quite a lull on this front now, but everybody is looking forward anxiously for the big event when we get the Germans on the run. It was exactly at this time last year that the Canadians made their immortal name, and I hope and trust that when the time comes there will be a repetition of those glorious victories—the second Battle of Ypres, St. Julien and Langemarck.

Every day we see fresh faces right from Canada. It is romantic to see the elite of manhood marching on such a deadly mission. However, we are fighting for a just cause and that damnable Prussian militarism must be given its death blow. The Hun's awful severe reverse at Verdun has
