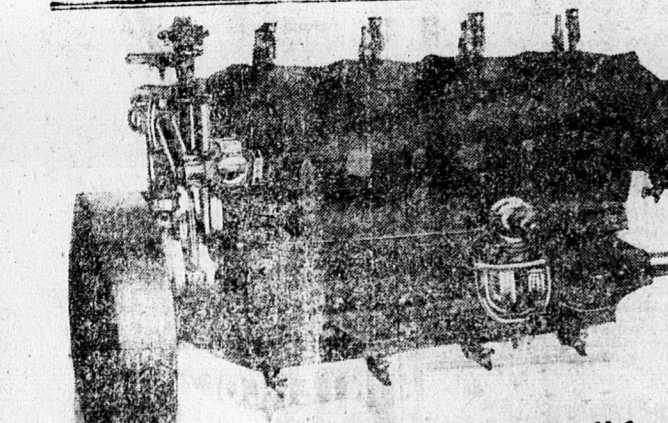

C., where he attended the annual meeting of the American Breeders' Association held in that city from December 28th to 30th. Mr. Raynor had, by invitation, prepared a paper on "Recent Progress in Breeding Black and Silver Foxes," which he read and which was very highly spoken of by the press. The history of fox breeding was new to the great majority of the 3000 people present at the meeting and, needless to say, elicited all kinds of questions and favorable comment. The extent to which fox breeding had already been carried in P. E. Island was a revelation to them. Mr. Raynor's estimate being that there are now in ranches here 200 good blacks, 300 light silvers and 500 reds and crosses. Mr. Raynor, we understand was the first to sell foxes for breeding purposes. Like several others he had been raising foxes for their pelts which he sold in London but finally, yielding to the solicitations of neighbors and believing that there was money in the business for others as well as himself, he began selling live ones, thus starting many on the road to fortune. He believes there is a great future for fox breeding and laughs at the idea of its ever being overdone. He bases this theory on the fact that the wild fur bearing animals are becoming extinct and the people must have furs. He thoroughly enjoyed his visit to Washington where he was most hospitably entertained by members of the Association.-Exc.
