JAPANESE TAKE INDIANS' FISH

Complaint Made by The Red Men Against Their Yellow Brethren--They Will Go To Ottawa To See About The Matter

VANCOUVER, B. C., Nov. 11.—Claiming that the Japanese are gradually depriving them of one of their principal sources of livelihood by embarking in the business of catching dog salmon on a wholesale scale, the Indians located at the northern end of Vancouver Island and on the Mainland opposite, intend to send a delegation to Ottawa to protest.

The delegation has caught the fancy of the Indians, and to them it presents almost illimitable possibilities for the righting of wrongs.

The salmon trouble is not the only one these northern Indians claim to have. They declare that in their agency, that of Alert Bay, the lands reserved for them are so poorly divided that there are some Indians without any real estate at all, while others have far too much. They want to explain these matters at first hand to Hon. Frank Oliver, Minister of the Interior.

The complaint of the Indians with respect to the Japanese taking their dog salmon may be well founded. The Orientals some years ago found that they could salt, export and market these salmon in Japan at a handsome profit. Year by year the export trade in these fish has been built up till at present many thousands tons are annually sent from Vancouver and Victoria to Japanese ports.

While the sailing business was commenced by the Japanese on the steamers in the vicinity of Vancouver, each succeeding season has sent them steadily advancing northward. Now the Indians claim that because of this Japanese competition, they cannot secure sufficient dog salmon for their needs.

ARE THE INDIANS SOCIALISTS?

With respect to the land question the Indians say that there are eighteen thousand acres under reserve in the agency. They say that half of that acreage is held by the Nawitchee tribe, which in the last three decades has so decreased in numbers that it now numbers only about seventy. The remainder of the land is held to be so unequally divided that the members of one little tribe have none at all.

Whether or not the Socialist idea has penetrated to the Indians is a moot question, but those who are standing around watching their neighbors harvest the crops are enthusiastic supporters of the principle that there should be a new idea in land all round.

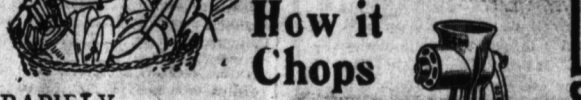
