Sprains

Cook's Corner

CHEESE CREAMS

The foundation of cheese creams is some cheese biscuits and rings. For the filling—Quarter of a pint of thick white sauce; 1 oz. grated cheese; 3 pennyworth of cream (or evaporated milk); 1 oz. grated Parmesan cheese; salt and cayenne for seasoning. Have the biscuits and rings ready. Mix the sauce, cheese milk or cream and seasonings together.
 Then fill the biscuits with this mixture, spreading some on one half and covering with the other half. Sprinkle a little very finely chopped parsley and red pepper on top of each biscuit and serve at once.
 Note—If the biscuits have been made beforehand, they should be reheated before being filled.
