A book recently published embodies the letters of a Chinaman long resident in America to a friend in his native land and deals with the religions of the United States. The writer concludes that no people make so general and united an attempt to be what they consider good and moral as the Americans.

The Chinese writer tells us that the impression on the Christian convert in China obtains is that the United States is a sort of paradise where Christians live in peace and happiness, loving one another, doing good to those that ill-treat them, turning the cheek to those that smite, etc., but the Chinaman in America soon learns that this spirit is often conspicuous by its absence.

the people of China are not so "pagan" as they suppose. Confucius taught the moral duties that ought to subsist between sovereign and subject, father and child, husband and wife, and with these five supreme virtues—universal charity, impartial justice, conformity to established usage, rectitude of heart and mind and pure sincerity. This is not a religion. There was no God distinctly taught in the Confucian system, but there was a broad moral system as high as that commonly in vogue today in Christian lands.

Australian Bushmen Have Gift of Prophecy as to Seasons. One of the most remarkable instances of science learning from savagery and instinct is that which is of everyday occurrence in Australia. The Australian natives are expert weather prophets. It is a gift that can hardly be called instinct, inasmuch as they form their judgment from a thousand and one signs about them, such as the average white would not notice. The appearance of the trees, the length of the stalk of certain reeds, the actions and doings of native animals, insects, reptiles and fish; in short, a thousand and one signs, the purport of which they have learned by long centuries of observation, constitute their stock in trade as weather prophets.
