**Black Fox Prices**

While the price of silver black foxes are steadily advancing it is thought by men most conversant with the market conditions, that they are still much below what will be high water mark for 1913. Within a very few weeks there has been a big jump in the market price, and it was stated the other day by a well known breeder of Prince Edward Island that he firmly believed that the price for silver black foxes by September of this year would be \$15,000 a pair. At present the prices for the best grade of silver black foxes are quoted at from \$10,000 upwards, so that the prospects for holders of black fox stock are very bright indeed. These prices, of course, apply only to the high grade, silver black foxes, and those companies which have as their stock tested breeders of good pedigree are sure to reap high dividends as a result of this rise in the market price. The Smith Silver Black Fox Company, Limited, has on its ranch island, and the shareholders stand to share in a profit that is conservatively estimated at 40 per cent.
