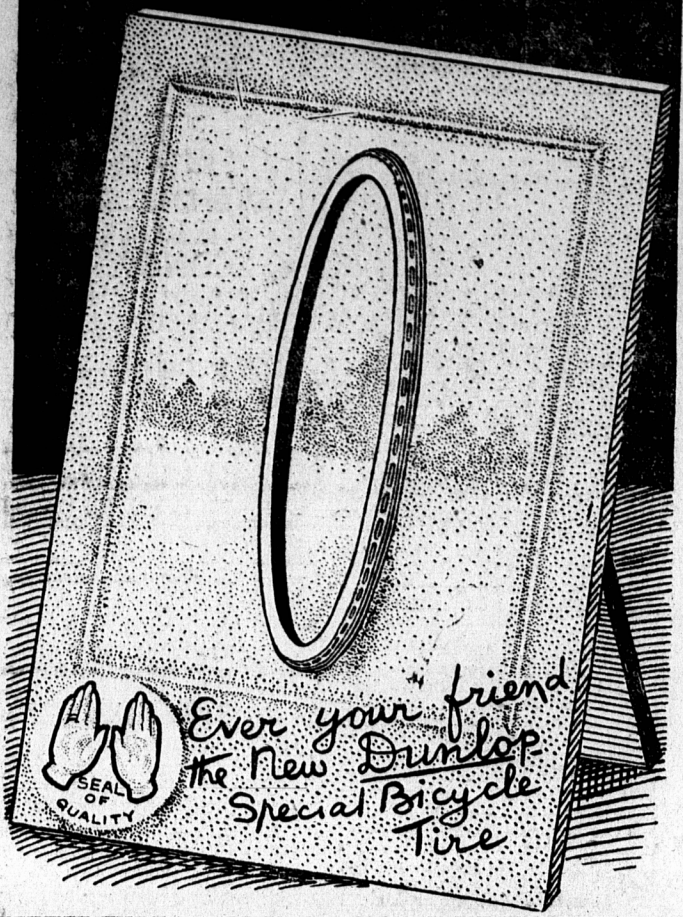

THE NEW FRENCH HERO.

General Lyautey, Who Attained Distinction in Morocco.

France begins to gossip about General Lyautey, recently placed in command of the Tenth army corps, with headquarters at Rennes. His services a few months ago on the Moroccan frontier brought him into notice, and the promotion above recorded came as a reward for his work at that time. He is credited with being something of a politician, as well as very much of a soldier, and it is such men who attract the attention of the French pretenders, royal and imperial, for any pretender to the throne of France knows that he cannot succeed without the good will of some capable and popular officers.

Boulanger, cheap hero though he was, demonstrated how far a military man of picturesque aspect could carry the French people. Fortunately the Boulanger episode is nearly a quarter of a century gone, and the republic is far stronger in the affections of France than it was in 1871.

General Lyautey endeared himself to his troops in Africa by a gay bonhomie rather unusual in the armies of Europe. He actually entered into gymnastic contests and carried off victories. At the same time he had not only the love but the respect of his troops and subalterns. He was sparing of French blood, and his soldiers were asked to take no unnecessary risks in their war with the wild tribes of north Africa. In that campaign he often wore the burnoose, and his appearance in the characteristic Arab dress was interesting and distinguished, for his tawny mustache and white hair contrasted oddly with the aspect of most who wear the garment.

General Lyautey is sixty-six years old, well read, fond of debate, devoted to the theater and a skilled writer of his native tongue.—Boston Herald.
