**GOING TO THE U.S.A.?**  
To avoid possible delay and embarrassment at border crossing points, be sure you have met the foreign exchange requirements before you set out. The travel ration of \$150 per person for the period November 16th, 1948, to November 15th, 1949 is to assure the fairest distribution of the U.S. funds available. For children under 11 years of age, the amount is \$100 U.S. If you are taking a trip to the United States, you need to secure a Form H permit to take out of Canada any amount exceeding \$10 U.S. or more than a total of \$25 in U.S. and Canadian Funds. Form H can be secured quickly and easily from branches of any Canadian Bank.

MONTREAL, April 19 - (CP) -  
Receipts were light and prices  
generally were steady on the two  
Montreal livestock markets today.  
Week-end receipts at the west-  
end yard totalled 695 cattle, 14  
sheep and lambs, 816 hogs and 1,531  
calves. Mid-morning offerings on  
the two markets today were 34  
cattle, one sheep, 59 hogs and 426  
calves, plus seven cars reported.  
Cattle sales were kept active de-  
spite light offerings, and prices  
were steady. Good cows 16-17, few  
at 17.50-18; medium 14-15.50;  
common 13-14; canners and cut-  
ters 10-12.50. Common bulls made  
14-18.  
Calves were slow movers. Ap-  
proximately 200 head were sold at  
steady prices. Medium veals 19-22  
and common ones 15 or better. Bid  
were about \$2 lower on the balance  
of offerings.  
Despite a weaker undertone in  
hog sales, grade A hogs made 30.  
Sows were unsettled and no early  
sales were registered.
