-At an early hour on Sunday morning the school house at South Kildare, about two miles from Alberton was destroyed by fire. The cause of the fire is unknown.

-Butter is selling in Summerside at twenty-two to twenty-six cents; eggs seventeen and a half to eighteen and a half cents. Oats, white thirty-eight cents per bushel and black at forty cents.

-The S. S. Campana is expected in Summerside early this morning on return to Montreal. Her cargo from Summerside will consist of four thousand bags potatoes, fifty barrels cranberries, fifty barrels oysters and four horses.

-Prices at Alberton yesterday were quoted as follows: White oats thirty-eight cents, black oats forty cents, hay per ton loose seven to eight dollars, pork eight cents, eggs seventeen and a half cents, butter twenty-two cents, oysters two seventy-five to three dollars per bushel and smelts three cents per lb.

-The marriage took place at Bideford on Monday evening last of Miss Ethel Champion, daughter of the late Benj. Champion to Russell Oulton of Alberton. The ceremony was performed by Rev. E. S. Weeks, B. A., B. D., in the presence of only a few relatives. After a dainty wedding supper the happy couple left for their home in Alberton.

-The death occurred on Sunday last, at Freeland, Lot 11, of Mrs. James Henderson. Deceased, who was about 84 years of age had been in her usual health until about ten days ago, when, by an unfortunate accident, she took a drink of concentrated lye, in mistake for some cordial. Medical aid was at once summoned but despite all that could be done she gradually failed until the end came, as stated. Her husband and several sons and daughters survive her, among them being D. P. Henderson, at home; Joshua, in Boston and Thomas and Parmens in United States.
