It is not that the circumstances of the present time and the policy of the opposition compel me so to do. When we remember that the Conservative party held power in this country, practically from confederation down to 1896, we will see that they were therefore clearly responsible for any wrong-doing, for an evil, for any misconduct, for any dishonesty that grew up in the departments or in the public life of the country. And as far back as 1873 we found the then Conservative government driven out of power because of their dishonest manipulation of a large public franchise and their attempted debauchery of the electorate of the country. It is true that some five years after, taking advantage of the universal depression that then prevailed and holding out delusive, false, vain expectations and hopes to the people, they obtained power and retained it for eighteen years afterwards. But by what means? By the employment of every device that perverted human ingenuity could make use of, till the Conservative party and government fell in 1896 like

Milton's angels overwhelmed in utter and irretrievable ruin and confusion. In 1891 Sir John Macdonald dissolved parliament on the specious plea that he wanted to obtain a mandate from the people to enable him to negotiate a reciprocity treaty at Washington as to which he pretended to have an invitation from the then Secretary of State, Mr. Blain, but this turned out to be a pure fabrication. The real reason for the dissolution of parliament at that time was to avoid the horrible disclosures, which, however, were made in the first session of the next parliament, and which the Conservatives in 1891 knew were impending. The trick succeeded, however. The Conservatives were returned to power, but their term in office was not prolonged. Their end was approaching; Nemesis had overtaken them; their cup of iniquity was full to overflowing, and finding their end approaching and finding that they could no longer prey on the country they turned upon and tried to rend one another. Sir Mackenzie Bowell has left us a record of the first sad days of the Conservative administration, of the plots and intrigues and the cabals which make so regrettable a chapter in our national history. I would not refer to this if it were a Liberal who made this statement, but Sir Mackenzie Bowell, had been for many years a colleague of these hon. gentlemen, for a time he had been their Prime Minister and leader, and he ought to know the character of the men he was dealing with and describing. And he has left this statement on record with regard to them:

A disgusted electorate upon the first opportunity thereafter relegated them to a forced retirement from office to the opposition benches where they will remain, if I can interpret public opinion, so long as they are recognized as important factors in the Conservative party.
