CANADA MUST CONTROL NAVY.

LONDON, March 19—Mr. J. Mortimer Clark, ex-Lieutenant Governor of Ontario, spoke at the luncheon of the Imperial Co-operation League today on Canada and the Navy. He said his ideal was an Imperial fleet in which overseas Dominions should be represented, but that leading the evolution of such a body the Canadian Parliament must control the Canadian contribution to the Imperial Navy.

Lord Strathcona endorsed this view and then Col. Seely expressed great regret at Mr. Brodeur's illness. Mr. Brodeur had mastered the naval situation.

NO MORE RACING AT OAK BAY TRACK.

VICTORIA, B. C., March 19—The race track gamblers of California, who with their famous sixty day limit brought Oak Bay, a suburb of Victoria, into disrepute last year, such an extent that the matter was taken up on the floor of Parliament during the debate on the bill to prohibit betting at races will never do it again. At a meeting of Oak Bay council last night a by-law was passed which stipulates that horse racing shall not take place within the corporate limits of the municipality of the district of Oak Bay. Heavy penalties are provided.

INGHAM IS ASSAILED ON HIS DIVORCE VIEWS.

LONDON, March 19—The fact that he has been the subject of an avalanche of criticism since his recent declaration of different standards of morality for men and women, Sir John Ingham, until a few days ago the president of the divorce division of the English courts, today reiterated his views, and sought to explain his position. "Misconduct by a man," he says, "has not anything like the significance as misconduct by a woman. On the part of a man it may be more or less accidental and not inconsistent with continued love and esteem of his wife. But misconduct by a woman is persistent with love and esteem of her husband." This explanation does not seem likely to reinstate Sir John in the good graces of those who disagree with him. Many of his friends, while admitting that what he says may be true, deprecate the recognition by law of a double standard. Sir John's former colleague on the divorce bench, Justice Bargrave Deane, is among those who most bitterly assail him. "I do not see how misconduct is more immoral on one side than the other," he said, "I think a great many men are immoral because they know that under English law their wives cannot divorce them for their immorality. If this law were changed it would act as a powerful deterrent."

It was the expression of Sir John's views before the Royal Commission on Divorce Law Reform that led to his withdrawal from the divorce courts.
