

ROTARIANS CELEBRATE QUARTER CENTURY USEFULNESS TUESDAY EVENING, NOVEMBER 10th.

The Charlottetown Rotary Club which attained its Charter in 1917 is celebrating its Silver Jubilee at The Charlottetown Hotel on Tuesday evening, November 10th, when the star attraction will be the guest speaker, Rev. E. Leslie Pidgeon, D.D., President of Rotary International in 1917-18, the year of Charlottetown's admission. Dr. Pidgeon also happens to be an Islander, with a world-wide reputation. During its existence the Rotary Club has stood behind most worthwhile public movements here, and has especially distinguished itself by adopting the Crippled Children Campaign as its own particular branch of Red Cross work, raising no less than \$20,000 for the carrying on of the good work. All citizens will join in congratulating the Rotarians on attaining this Red Letter Day in their history, and cherish the hope that the Club may be long spared to continue its beneficent work.
