NATURAL GAS.

Of natural gas the people of this continent burn usefully in a year fully \$800,000,000 cubic feet—equivalent to the heating value of 40,000,000 tons of coal, and something like \$600,000 families are directly benefited by it in cooking, heating and lighting. But the most significant aspect of this matter is that approximately two-thirds of the gas is used industrially. The history of our treatment of natural gas is a record of wanton waste. Just think of it, in the course of one month gas was allowed to escape unburned from a well which has yielded 600,000,000 cubic feet. This is equivalent to 250,000 tons of coal, enough to supply 50,000 households for a year. By recourse to moderate expense for proper casing at our gaswells an enormous conservation of this fuel might be effected. Scientific American.

IN MEMORIAM

MR. ANGUS MACPHAIL

The death occurred at the residence of his daughter Mrs. George A. Paule, Lower Montague, yesterday morning, of Mr. Angus MacPhail at the advanced age of 92 years.

Mr. MacPhail was a native of West River. He learned the trade of book making when in the shipbuilding industry. Flourished in this province, and was for a time engaged in the woodworking business at Georgetown and Montague. Subsequently he removed to Duluth, Minn., with his family. He remained in that city for many years but after the death of his wife he returned to the Island about the year 1913 and has since been with his daughter in Lower Montague.

The late Mr. MacPhail was a man of sterling qualities of mind and heart and was held in the highest esteem by all who knew him.

He was a member of the Masonic Order belonging to St. George's Lodge of Georgetown, one of the oldest lodges on the Island.

He leaves tomorrow two sons and three daughters. The sons are Charles in Duluth, Minn.; and the daughters are Miss Ella in Portland, Oregon; Mrs. J. D. Porter in Spokane, Wash.; and Mrs. George A. Paule, Lower Montague.

The funeral will be held from Mr. Paule's residence on Wednesday at 2 p. m.

Henry Ford To See

Have Invention To Conserve Moisture

DESIGNER OF MACHINE WILL DISCUSS MANUFACTURE OF TOOL WITH AUTO MAGNATE

HAVRE, March 27.—Henry Hales, a local inventor expects to leave soon for the east to present a tool invented to aid in the conservation of moisture to the attention of Henry Ford, with a view to its manufacture. Mr. Hales has had 25 years experience in farming and he has invented a machine, which his clients claim, will revolutionize the industry in the more arid districts of the country.

The machine is designed to conserve and hold the moisture of the early spring rains, so that it may prove of benefit to crops in the growing season. It is so constructed that it may be attached to a plow or harrow, or a groove in the subsoil which will act as a storage tank to hold the early moisture in the soil to the nourishment of plants later on and thus insure a crop which might otherwise be a failure.

Mr. Hales has designed his machine so that the depth of the cutters may be adjusted to suit the character of the ground. The adjustment is made by means of a lever which secures the cutters at the desired depth and the 'v' shaped groove that has been made will be filled with the loose mould soil as the machine is worked over on the surface. The soil may be so packed to their full depth. This would be done when preparing the ground for the second crop.

Mr. Hales, above referred to, is a son of the late Mr. F. W. Hales, for many years secretary of the Charlottetown Steam Navigation Co. Mr. Hales is a cousin of Col. S. R. Jenkins, this city.
