Stock Prices Slip Lower On Montreal Mart

MONTREAL, Aug. 22 (CP)- Lacking buying support, the stock market floated gently lower today in the lightest trading for more than two months.

Equipment and paper issues almost without exception moved to the lower side of the market. Quarter-point declines were registered for St. Lawrence paper preferred, Canadian Car preferred and Dominion Steel and coal "B" while National Steel Car drifted a half.

In the metals, Noranda and Hollinger showed fairly substantial gains while Nickel and Smelters eased about a half-point each. Constructions also were mixed, Dominion Bridge gaining a half point while Steel of Canada slipped a similar amount.

Montreal Power climbed 1-4 of 31, but a sudden burst of selling point to a new high for the year at the close shot it down 3-4 point to close at 30 1-4. Other losers included C. P. R. and National Breweries, off a quarter-point each.

Grain WINNIPEG, Aug. 22 (CP)-

Winnipeg wheat futures were fairly steady in a listless session today with final values unchanged. Nov. 67 5-8 Dec. 67 1-4 and May 67 1-4 cent lower, Oct. 67 3-4, 70 3-8-1-2.

Small advances were scored in the initial hour owing to the better tone at Liverpool but reactions occurred when agent selling developed at the half-way mark.

Dealings throughout were narrow with most traders finding little incentive to either buy or sell.

North American clearances were 4,402,000 bushels, an increase of slightly more than 200,000 bushels. Western Canada wheat marketings Saturday took a big jump compared with new crop deliveries a year ago. They totaled 2,034,000 bushels against only 959,000 bushels last year.

Cas wheat ceilings were dull with most spreads unchanged. Coarse grain futures were steady, hedging pressure in barley was offset by a fair export demand.
