## SELF GOVERNMENT GREAT MORAL POWER

Continued from page 1. This obedience is called piety and is the great consummation of true Christian character; but the obedience to be rendered is not slavish submission to arbitrary laws designed to promote the power of ambition of an unscrupulous prince or potentate, but obedience to the laws of love and peace that cement the elements of Heaven and bind together in amity and friendship, the best and purest tenantry of earth, and to which the bent of our nature impels and inclines us when led by the Divine spirit. In the Scriptural sense, piety is the controlling of all passions, consistently with the frail tenure upon which human life is morally constituted, within the limits of the inspired law. It is not expected that any man will be absolutely, or in anything more than relatively, perfect, but the rule would seem to be for us to do the best we can as the Lord and man both expect of us. "not according to that we have, but according to that we have," and neither angels nor men can do better.

Self government implies strong individuality, self-sustaining power, that relies not upon the caprice or judgment of every acquaintance but upon its own individualized decisions and personality of thought, those noble and distinguishing characteristics of real merit and genuine manhood. "Know thyself" was written over the vestibule of the ancient temple of Delhi, and surely no lesson of deeper interest could be proposed to human understanding, but there are very few who trouble much about compassing themselves though they may be the greatest critics and adjudicators of other men's presentations.

The man who does not strive to understand those great forces, mental, moral and physical, lodged in his own organism for his own good, the benefit of society and the glory of God, can never possess his soul or govern that portion of humanity allotted as a sacred charge to his care. But as the physical man is subordinated to the mental man who sits enthroned in "the home of thought and palace of the soul" and enunciates his decrees, so the normal man—the enshrined Divinity in humanity—holds the scales of justice in one hand, and the balance of justice and equity in the other, issues its decrees to the mind itself and claims its homage. As the mind governs matter and the moral sentiments govern the mind, so does the Great Supreme rule all—our body and spirit—and they are subordinate to his purposes. In doing this he has his own style of discipline, and his own mode of government; but he desires not the death of any; however, he will not suspend the essential laws of our being, or the universe upon which the well-being and prosperity of this entire planet depends, even should the result be the destruction of thousands and ten thousands of human beings. The law of gravitation that holds together worlds, may crush to atoms the delicate frame of beauty, or the tender form of helpless innocence; the atmosphere which bathes our globe on all sides for miles, is often so gentle in its undulations that it would not disturb the petals of a rose, the

With the Holy Spirit sanctifying our moral sentiments with the truth of the Gospel, the moral sentiments guiding and directing the intellect into channels of duty, and the mind—the entompled God of humanity—directing and controlling the physical powers, what dignity as a diadem and a tiara of beauty will adorn and grace the brow of such an ennobled humanity.

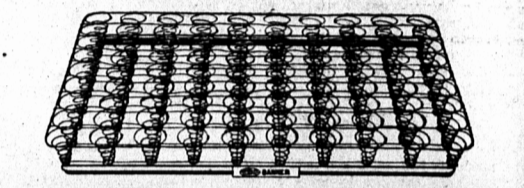

## YNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH WEST HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS

Any even numbered section of Dominion Land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 26, not reserved may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of the family, or any male over 18 years of age to the extent of one-quarter section 160 acres, more or less.

Applications for entry must be made in person by the applicant at a Dominion Land Agency or Sub-agency for the district in which the land is situated. Entry by proxy may however, be made at an Agency on certain conditions by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of any intending homesteader. The homesteader is required to perform the homestead duties under one of the following plans.

(1) At least six months residence upon the cultivation of the land in each year for three years.

(2) A homesteader may, if he so desire, perform the required residence duties by living on farming land owned solely by him not less than eighty (80) acres in extent, in the vicinity of his homestead. Joint ownership in land will not meet this requirement.

(3) If the father (or mother, if the father is deceased) of homesteader has permanent residence on farming land owned solely by him, not less than eighty (80) acres in extent in the vicinity of the homestead, or upon a homestead entered by him in the vicinity such homesteader may perform his own residence duties by living with the (father, or mother.)

(4) The term "vicinity" in the two preceding paragraphs is defined as meaning not more than nine miles in a direct line, exclusive of the width of road allowances crossed in the measurement.

(5) A homesteader intending to perform his residence duties in accordance with the above while living with parents or on farming land owned by himself must notify the Agent for the district of such intention. Six months' notice in writing should be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa, of intention to apply for patent. W. W. CORY, Deputy of the minister of the Interior. N.
