LONDON, May 4.—Another interesting centenarian has passed away, the oldest subject of the King, aged 121 years. This was Wm. Stuart, who died at Gortley Letterkeny, Ire'nd. When a boy he saw Admiral Warren's battleships in Lough Solly, in 1798, after he had defeated and captured the French squadron, with which was Wolf Tone, the notorious Irish rebel.
