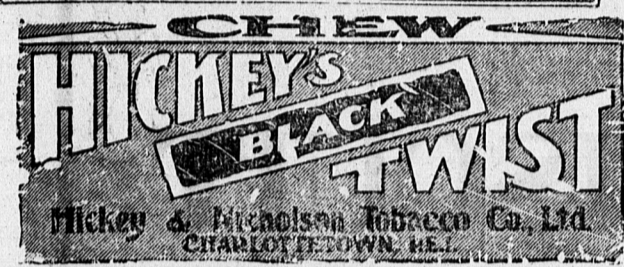

They arrived in Charlottetown on Saturday night and as they were due in Halifax on the following Wednesday evening their stay here did not permit of a visit to Tignish. To address a meeting at Tignish would necessarily have involved the cancelling of their engagement not only in Halifax but at other places. No one regrets more than the Premier that these visitors could not visit Tignish, Palmer Road, Rustico and other centres but under the circumstances such was impossible. The Premier did the best he could to have the French Officers see as much of the Island as possible in the limited time at their disposal and if the centres referred to were omitted it was for cause not within his control.

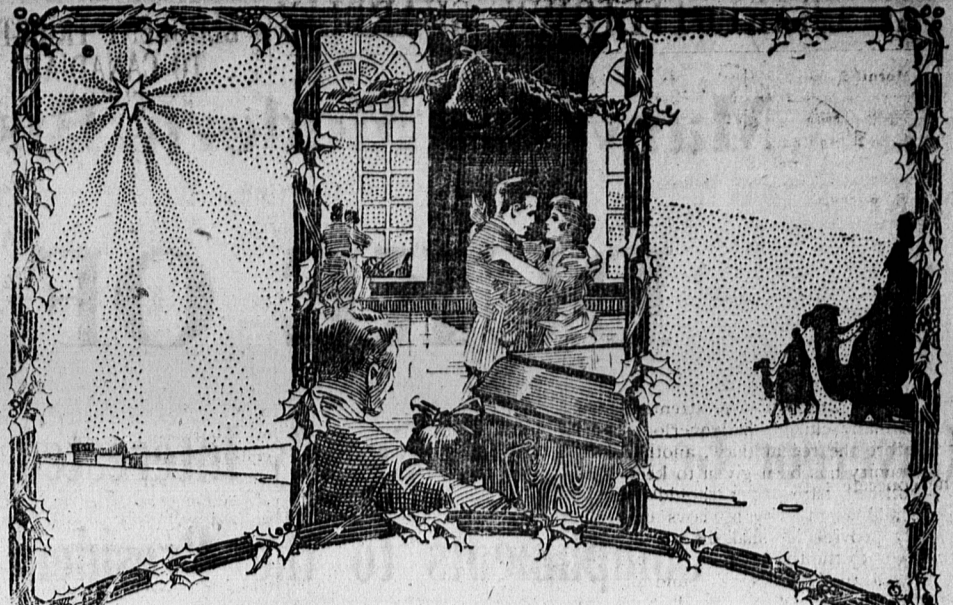
