Stock Market Prices Closed Higher Yesterday

TORONTO, March 24—(CP)—Base metals showed increased activity with several leaders advancing strongly on the Toronto stock exchange today although New Calumet, Normetal, Sherritt, East Sullivan and United Kenn Hill were lower.

Quesomet and Hudson Bay were strong fractionally and Bend Ore-ille and Labrador added pennies. Senior golds were better and some junior producers showed gains ranging up to five cents. Eldorado sagged following news that the mine at Klondike Lake would suspend operations by the end of spring. Western oils were the only group to show a loss on the exchange's index. Anglo-Canadian lost 15 cents at \$3.70 and Foothills and Royaltie were down five cents. The exchange's closing index showed gold up .53 at 94.56, base metals up .89 at 94.85, western oils down .46 at 46.97. Golds listed 43 gains, 47 losses, 41 unchanged; base metals, 9 gains, 11 losses, 7 unchanged; western oils, 4 gains, 8 losses, 7 unchanged.

At Montreal MONTREAL, March 24—(CP)—Stocks worked into higher ground in heavier trading on the Montreal stock exchange and curb market today, with advances of as much as four points shown by leading industrials. The uptrend started yesterday following release of the 1949 Federal budget. Canadian Vickers Preferred topped the list, with a four-point jump to a new high of 160, following announcement here today that the company would redeem the issue at \$110, plus arrears and current dividends to May 1. The Common added two points to a new high of 84 after touching 80 near the final hour. Power Corporation, holding substantial interest in the Mid-Western Power Company, rose 1 1/4 to 14 3/4. Metals dipped slightly with International Nickel and Aluminum down 1/4 each at 32 1/4 and 54, respectively. Bathurst, Fraser, Howard Smith, St. Lawrence Paper, Second Pref. Paper, Consolidated Paper and Great Lakes were fractionally higher in a broad list. Brown dipped 1/8 to a new low of 3 1/4, while Price, Abitibi, Common and Preferred were minor losers.

At New York NEW YORK, March 24—(AP)—The stock market closed with gains of fractions to a point or so in the majority today—but at the end of the price level was curving downward. Opening demand represented a pile of orders which had built up overnight following the snappy rise in Wednesday's trading when one of the largest overall gains of the year was scored. There was no follow-through, however. Turnover of \$20,000 shares compared with \$60,000 yesterday, which was tops for the month. The Associated Press average of 60 stocks advanced 3 of one point to 63.6, the highest of the past 10 days. Rail stocks did better than average today, evidently a further reflection of the 75-cent dividend voted by the Pennsylvania R. R. board yesterday.
