

Wool Marketing

Wool will be received at the Potato Growers' Warehouse at the foot of Prince Street, Charlottetown, after June 17th. Wool shipped by rail should be carefully tagged and addressed to the Wool Grading Station, Charlottetown, "Freight Collect." Wool shipped by truck will be entitled to rail rates only. Truckers must present a proper warehouse receipt before truckage will be paid. An advance of 20c per lb. will be made on all wool of satisfactory quality and properly prepared for marketing. The balance will be paid as soon as wool is graded.

In shipping, each fleece should be tied separately with paper string and packed in old, but clean sacking. Do not ship in large number of bags. Use one large sack if at all possible, as this aids in checking. A number of old, clean socks sewed together will suffice. Each sack should be tagged with the name and address of the owner written in clear lettering with ink, one tag to be securely attached to the outside of the sack and another placed on the inside. No responsibility will be accepted for sacks without tags. A deduction of 01c per lb. will be made for wool tied with binder paper twine or other unsatisfactory string. Shipping tags and proper paper twine are available at the Provincial Department of Agriculture free of charge.

It is in your interest to see that wool is properly prepared for market. Growers should

1. Remove all tags and dung locks before tying each fleece.
2. Any burry, chaffy, or strawy portions of wool should also be removed and shipped separately.
3. Sheep should be shorn when dry, and wool should be stored in a place free from dampness.

All wool should be delivered between June 16th and July 19th.

Contract Bridge

A POINT FOR DEFENDERS
It does not always pay a defender to "cash in" small trumps by over-ruffing the declarer or the gummy. Terence Reese, a leading British authority, illustrates this point well in an article on defensive tactics in The Bridge World Magazine. His hand is:

♠ 7 4 2
♥ 6
♦ 10 6 5 3
♣ A J 4 2

♠ A 9 3

With both sides vulnerable and North-South 30 on score, South West opens the club ten. The ace reaches a contract on three spades. West opens the club ten. The ace wins and the heart six is led from dummy. East plays the deuce, declarer the jack and West the ace. West now leads another club, which declarer ruffs.

South ruffs a low heart in dummy and returns a trump. East ducks and South wins. Another low heart is now ruffed—and East, holding the A-9 of trumps blank, should restrain himself and not over-ruff! Declarer has already been shortened in trumps; if East merely discards on this trick, South will have to ruff himself down further to return to his own hand and will then have the same number of trumps that East has. That fact in itself will put South in a hopeless position. He cannot draw trumps, nor can he make this nine

tricks by leading out good hearts. He has lost trump control of the hand.

If, however, East seizes the chance to make his spade nine, on an over-ruff of dummy, he gives up the defense then and there, since he leaves South with enough trumps for full control.

It will repay readers to lay out the cards in this case and study the effect of over-ruffing by East and also refusal to over-ruff. It is like so many other situations in bridge—the so-called "natural" play, however tempting, may be revealed as unsound when put under the microscope of close analysis.

BOXING #51 . . . SKILL DRILLS

LEFT vs. RIGHT
One boxer holds right hand behind back, punches only with left. Other boxer uses only right to guard, does no punching. Change every 3 minutes. Great practice!

CIRCLE BOUT
Draw 8 foot circle on ground or floor. Then, spar within circle. This practice develops skill at close range.

PUNCH ACCURACY
Have pal stand 10-15 feet away and throw rubber tennis ball at your shoulder high. Try to punch ball back so he can catch it. A real skill developer!
