Announcement by Agriculture Minister Gardiner that the cattle embargo to the United States would be lifted next Monday and export permits would be issued freely to those wishing to export oats and barley from Canada, today stimulated buying in coarse grains on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange.  
Trading in coarse grains was extremely active and featured good export demand in barley. Shippers were active buyers in both grains. Some American buying came into oats. Moderate offerings in barley were well absorbed, although there were some recessions from the highs.  
Rye futures trading saw continuation of seaboard demand and prices showed a better tone New crop hedging was well taken.
