(By The Canadian Press) NEW YORK, Oct. 29 - The United States Government looked with greater optimism on the troubled labor scene today in spite of new and serious strike threats in major industries.

While more automobile workers voted in favor of strike action to support wage increase demands...

But in Detroit, the National Labor Relations Board announced that Chrysler Corporation workers had voted 19,970 to 2,359 in favor of a walk-out in support of demands for a general wage increase of 30 per cent.

And in Pittsburgh, Philip Murray, president of the C.I.O. and the United Steel Workers, said he hoped to have strike vote petitioned.
