SHIPPING LOSSES

LONDON, Dec. 28.—The losses to British shipping show a material decrease for the past week. According to the Admiralty report tonight eleven British merchantmen of 1,600 tons or over were sunk during this period by mine or submarine, as well as some merchantmen under that tonnage, and one fishing vessel.

The summary: Arrivals, 2,316; sailings, 2,460. British merchantmen sunk by mine or submarine, 1,600 tons or over, 11. Under 1,600 tons, one; fishing vessels, one. British merchantmen unsuccessfully attacked, twelve, including two previously.

THE BROTHERHOOD AND GOVERNMENT CONTROLS RAILWAYS

(Canadian Press Despatch) WASHINGTON, Dec. 27.—The railway Brotherhood Chiefs went to the White House this afternoon to discuss changes in their relationship with the railroads caused by government operation, particularly the question of whether Director General McAdoo will deal directly with the men in their pending demand for forty per cent. higher wages, or whether he will authorize a committee of managers to negotiate as in the past. It was understood Mr. McAdoo had reached no conclusion as to the best method of procedure but that he probably would favor allowing the managers to throw out wage questions for later submission to him. Brotherhood leaders explained that the railroads had until the end of this month to give an answer on whether they will negotiate with the men on the forty per cent. wage demand and that the government operation plan probably will deal with this procedure somewhat. No strike is threatened, but emphasized and the president already has been secured the support of the workmen.
