SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, may homestead a quarter section of a valuable Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta.

Disties—Must reside upon the homestead or pre-emption at least one year in each of six years from date of homestead entry including the time required to clear, fence, plant and cultivate 100 acres extra.
