## A SKATING CIRCUIT.

President Lewis Rubenstein has been notified of an Annual Meeting.

MONTREAL, Dec. 19. - President Louis Rubenstein, of the Canadian Amateur Hockey Association, has been notified that at the annual meeting of the National Amateur Skating Association, held in New York last week, it was decided to follow the example of the lawn tennis and golf associations of the United States and divide the championship meeting this winter, holding a Western championship meeting at St. Paul, Minn., and an Eastern championship at Newburg, N. Y. under the auspices of the Newburg Wheelmen.

The Canadian championship meeting will be held on the M. A. A. Rink, this city, February 3, and it is the wish of the National Association that, if possible, the Western meeting should be held January 26 and 27, and the Eastern championship meeting February 9 and 10, thus making a circuit of three meetings, at which all the champions might compete, so far as their time and money would permit.

The three meetings will be exclusively amateur. The Canadians who have the matter in hand have decided to exclude the professionals, regardless of what may happen to the gate receipts. They contend, with much force, that the only way to boom amateur skating in this country, is to keep the money-making speeders out of the championship meeting entirely.
