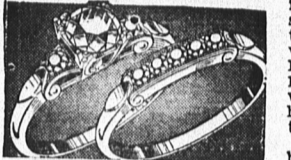

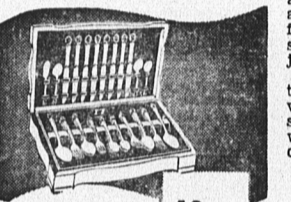

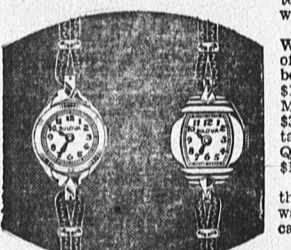

PETAWAWA HOME CENTRE

Petawawa Home Centre was endorsed by the Canadian W. C. T. U. as a War Project because it is a permanent camp.

The building is not an amusement centre but for religious meetings and for personal work with soldiers.

The MINIMUM AMOUNT asked for the building was \$4,000.00. Owning to the increased price of materials and labor more, no doubt will be needed.

According to the new Canadian W. C. T. U. Report the allocation of each Province according to membership is as follows:—Alberta, \$182.50; British Columbia, \$307.00; Manitoba, \$93.00; New Brunswick, \$316.00; Nova Scotia, \$205.50; Ontario, \$2,639.00; P. E. Island, \$40.00; Quebec, \$879.50; Saskatchewan, \$150.00; Y. W. C. T. U., \$311.00.

Manitoba has already gone over the top. At last accounts Alberta was within a few dollars of its allocation.

It is evident the Home Centre is approved by all Provinces. Provincial Treasurers are requested to forward contributions promptly to the Canadian Treasurer, Mrs. W. P. Wallace, Winnipeg, and at the same time a card to me telling the amount that plans may be made forthwith.
