SEAL CATCH CLOSE TO 400,000.

St JOHN'S, N.F., March 26.—Two more sealing steamers have arrived the Aurora with a catch of 32,000 and the Diana, with 28,000. They report that all the other ships have from 10,000 to 25,000 seals each aboard. The whole catch is likely to approach 400,000 being the largest in twenty years.
