THE COOK'S CORNER

Butterscotch Slices (First Part)

1 cup flour 3-4 cup brown sugar 1-2 cup butter. Method: Sift the flour and mix the brown sugar with it. Add the butter and crumble these together. Pat this mixture into a lightly greased pan and bake in a moderate, 350 deg. F. oven for 15 minutes. Meanwhile prepare the second part.

(Second Part) 2 eggs 2 tablespoons flour, 1 cup brown sugar, 1-2 teaspoon baking powder, 1 cup chopped nuts, 1 cup shredded coconut, 1-2 teaspoon vanilla.

Remove the pan containing the first part from the oven and pour this over the pastry. Return to the oven and continue to bake for about 20 minutes longer, until the top layer is done. Cut in squares and cool on a cake rack.

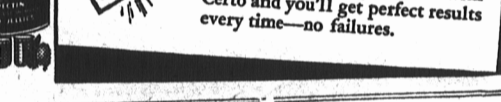
