PLAY FOR COMBINATION OF CHANCES

Strictly as a matter of "percentage," a declarer should finesse for a missing king even if he has 10 cards in that suit—the finesse has a substantially better chance than the play for a "drop." However, under many different circumstances, the finesse should be abandoned—not because of a change in probabilities, but because the "drop" play can be combined with another possibility to great advantage. The following deal, which is thoroughly typical, illustrates this point:
