

Labor Minister Gives Order For Review Of Work Laws

OTTAWA (CP)—Labor Minister MacEachen has ordered his departmental experts to make a general review of Canada's labor laws in a new move aimed at overhauling federal legislation dealing with industrial relations and working conditions.

Reliable sources say high priority is being given to an intensive study by labor department specialists of the social, economic and political repercussions of a federal labor code. Such a code—promised during the election campaign by Prime Minister Pearson—would establish a minimum wage of \$25 an hour, a maximum normal work week of 40 hours, two weeks vacation with pay after one year on a job, plus seven statutory holidays with pay.

The code would apply to industries under federal jurisdiction—involving some 500,000 workers employed chiefly on the banks, broadcasting stations and grain elevators.

A national labor code would also set a standard that the provinces would likely be asked to adopt within their jurisdictions. Right now, there is a variety of provincial laws dealing with minimum wages, annual vacations, statutory holidays and hours of work.

REVISOR'S REVISIONS

Mr. MacEachen is also understood to have asked his experts the proposals to improve and speed up the conciliation process that unions and management in the federal field must follow whenever their collective bargaining talks break down.

Some of the initial studies in this over-all review program are already flowing across Mr. MacEachen's desk, but no specific plans for legislative action have been laid before the cabinet yet.

Informants said once the review in all its various phases is complete, then priorities for parliamentary action will be established and specific proposals could be presented to the cabinet.

The government has hinted in the Commons that it is eager to act on its election promise.

PC Leader Plans Tour

OTTAWA (CP)—Progressive Conservative leader Dief-Baker is joining the ranks of peripatetic party leaders.

Mr. Dief-Baker, just back from two weeks of fishing in northern Saskatchewan, plans to leave next week for a three-week tour of Europe and the Middle East, including stops in Egypt and Israel.

At present, New Democratic Party leader Douglas is in Europe and Social Credit leader Thompson has a trip planned to New Zealand and Australia.

A fall visit to Paris and possibly one to Australia may be in the works for Prime Minister Pearson.
