

Hepatitis Outbreak Reported

ORILLIA, Ont. (CP)—An outbreak of infectious hepatitis has forced a ban on Christmas season visits to the isolation ward of the Ontario Hospital school here, Acting Superintendent Dr Crawford Jones has disclosed.

He said there was no cause for alarm. About 44 children are affected, 10 having contracted the disease and the others under observation as suspected carriers.

"Our main concern is to keep them isolated and prevent the spread of the germ to the broad winner of the family," Dr Jones said.

Dr. G. M. Hopwood, in charge of the isolation ward, said the first cases were detected about two months ago.

The disease, affecting the liver and often giving the patient a jaundiced appearance, is usually contracted by "eating something that has been infected" or from the breath of an infected person. r. Hopwood said.

Yes, we admit we attended more than one of the parties and they were a lot of fun. Few of the younger class ever saw the Indian war dance and the scalping of the white man. The dance was carried on as a sport and the scalping done with a narrow shingle instead of a knife, all in fun.

Since writing the above we learned with regret that Martin Thomas died very suddenly at the reserve on Thursday and was buried in the family plot of the Church of St. Laurence here on Saturday. Two daughters reside in the city and we extend our sincere regrets.
