Community Planning Importance Outlined

MONTAGUE — A meeting to consider the feasibility of regional association planning was held last night at Montague. Present at the meeting were representatives from Carleton Place, Georgetown, Murray River, Murray Harbour, and a Montague.

F. J. Storey, Charlottetown, chairman of a steering committee, presided over the meeting. Also present was Walter de Silva, professional town planner for the province. Mr. F. Hagan of the Metropolitan Committee, Charlottetown; Claude Smith, director of town planning for the province, all of whom addressed the meeting.

Mr. Storey briefly outlined the situation of community planning as it exists in the province at present, stating that the meeting was called to discuss the merits of a provincial association pointing out that a steering committee had been appointed some time ago to look into the matter of forming a provincial association. Mr. Storey, Walter Clark and G. K. Peake were appointed to this committee.

At last night's meeting it was decided that representatives from each of the communities of the province should meet at a central location to hear an address by some expert on the matter following which a decision possibly could be reached to form a provincial community planning association.
