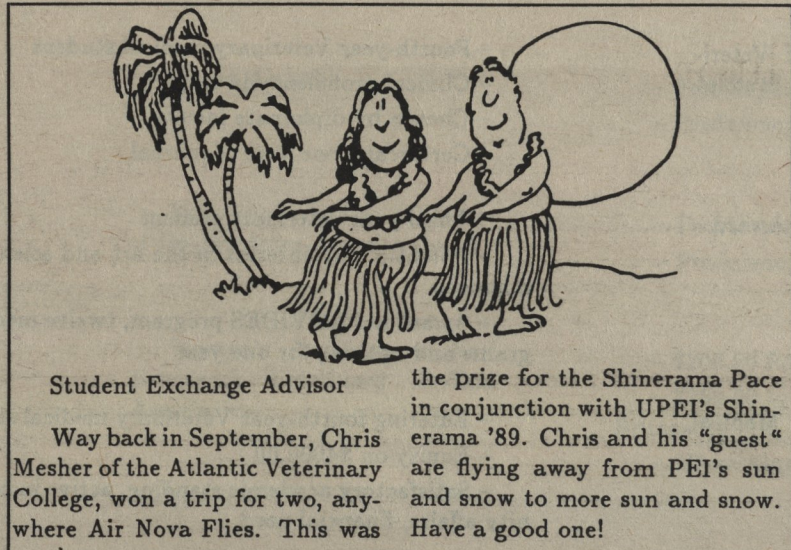

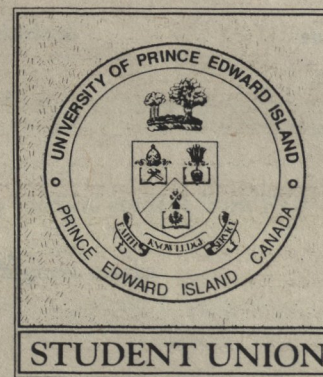
you see them complaining in the Gem? I don't.
