Home distilling, outlawed in most countries, is legal in France. Here, three million two hundred and fifty thousand persons have licences and distill alcohol from grapes, prunes etc.  
 France has one grog shop for every 90 inhabitants, Germany one for every 246 persons, England one for every 430, Norway one for every 3,000 inhabitants.  
 One would naturally think that wine would be a great source of revenue for France. Not so. Wine accounts for less than six percent of French export.  
 Under Premier Laniel, home distillers will be required to pay a tax for the first time.  
 The alcohol hobby is a powerful force in France, representing one hundred and twenty thousand growers and one and one-half million families who earn their bread and butter from King Alcohol.  
 If you have a sleepwalker in your family, remember that somnambulists should never be awakened suddenly in strange surroundings. If told to go back to bed, or guided by the arm, the sleepwalker will usually respond. The royal crown of England weighs five pounds and can't be worn with comfort.

Fortunately, people cannot be treated like bees or there might be some interesting developments from an experiment recently made by the Agriculture Division, Dept. of Agriculture, Ottawa.  
 Treating bees with nitrous oxide gas apparently causes them to lose memory of their location. Normally, when colonies of bees are moved short distances, as may be required for the pollination of certain crops of fruit trees, the bees tend to return to the old rather than the new location of the hive.  
 In a recent test at Ottawa, six colonies were gassed lightly with nitrous oxide, and then moved 500 yards to an orchard which required pollination. The bees did not return as their owners had expected they would but stayed in the new location.  
 If later trials confirm this result, beekeepers will be able to move their hives short distances to new areas of blooms in the same or adjacent fields. This will give more effective pollination of fruit and clover crops and cut down the distance the bees have to travel.  
 Tests reveal that the average man can slam down the brakes of his car in an emergency in 57/100 of a second. A woman driver takes 62/100 of a second to react to a red light, take her foot off the gas and push the brake pedal.
