Canadian Apple Exports To U.K. Increase Sharply

OTTAWA (CP)—A sharp increase in Canadian apple exports to the United Kingdom despite heavy British production was announced Tuesday by Agriculture Minister Harkness. Canadian shipments this season totalled 616,000 boxes to the end of January, up 100,000 boxes from exports in the comparable period a year earlier.
