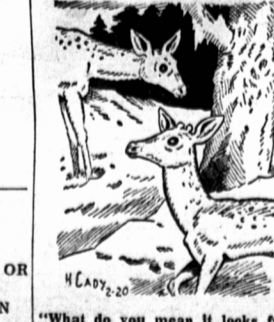

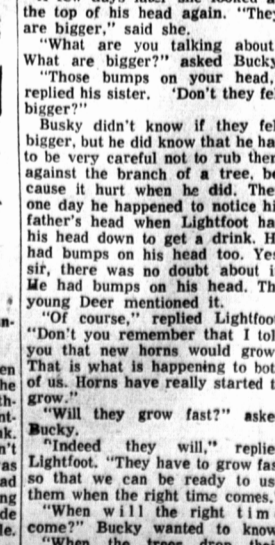

Will Report Life Of Immigrants

SAINT JOHN, N.B. (CP)—The liner Empress of Britain, making her last call of the season at Saint John, is due Thursday with nearly 900 passengers, including more than 400 immigrants from the United Kingdom and 251 Hungarian refugees.

One family is that of Pat Haughian of Glasgow, who was a workman in shipyards on the Clyde. Malcolm Munro, a writer for the Glasgow Evening Citizen, is accompanying the family and will describe his experiences before and after settling in Toronto.

WANTS MORE AID

Correspondence from Saskatchewan dealt at length with problems involved in settling the refugees from Communist brutality in Hungary and indicated costs are running higher than expected.

But aside from offering to take on responsibility in cases where normal immigration health standards were waived, the federal government rejected Saskatchewan demands for more financial aid. Presumably, it would hold the same attitude toward other provinces.

OTHERS AGREE

The federal and Saskatchewan governments reached agreement on sharing costs for settlement of Hungarians last Dec. 3. The correspondence showed that federal officials for the last several weeks had been negotiating with other provinces for similar arrangements.
