New York Stocks

NEW YORK, (AP)— A last-minute urge to buy sent the stock market slightly to the upside Thursday.

The rally, with selected steels, motors, chemicals and aircrafts leading the way, turned the market around. It had been drifting lower almost from the start.

Volume was 1,800,000 shares. The hike in steel prices by U. S. Steel was ignored by the market until the final hour, when that stock grew active and gained 1-8 at 49 1/8 after selling lower all day. The rest of the steels were mixed.

General Motors was a market leader with a gain of 1-1/2 at 74 1/4 and both Goodrich and Goodyear achieved good gains. In the utility group, Consolidated Natural Gas was up better than a point.

Rails were irregular while oil again were almost uniformly low.

Advancing stocks included Allium Chemical, Schenley, Santa Fe, American Woolen, International Paper, Chrysler and American Oil. Lower were
