New Assessment Made Of Petroleum Exports To U.S.

By ARCH MACKENZIE WASHINGTON (CP) - The future pattern of Canadian petroleum exports to the United States is being weighed again here after an unexpected decision last week by the Canadian cabinet.

This decision rejected a move by Trans-Canada Pipe Lines Limited, in alliance with American companies, to supply additional natural gas to Ontario via the United States, while increasing exports en route at the same time.

Prime Minister Pearson, in a statement interpreted here as politically motivated, expressed fear the proposed U.S. line would supplant the all-Canada route north of the Great Lakes as the major feed for Eastern Canada.

That announcement Thursday has ended the prolonged hearing begun here April 19 before the federal power commission on the merits of the Trans-Canada plan as opposed by a rival concept from Northern Natural Gas Co. of Omaha.

Interest Rates Worry Johnson

By Federal Power Commission staff urged rejection of both plans. The report dated Monday proposed instead the utilization of existing pipeline links in Wisconsin, Minnesota and Michigan to feed Ontario and hold down costs as has been urged by President Johnson.

SAN ANTONIO, Tex. (AP) - President Johnson expressed concern Monday over rising interest rates, but said he disagrees with former president Harry Truman, who said during

the weekend that they could result in a serious depression. Johnson said in a statement "I cannot agree with President Truman that our economy is in danger of recession or depression. The tightness of money mainly reflects the extreme buoyance of our economy and the resulting very sharp rise in the demand for credit."
