TORONTO (CP)—Art galleries of Ottawa, Montreal and Toronto have collaborated to show what Canada has in the way of collected European art painted largely before the 20th century.

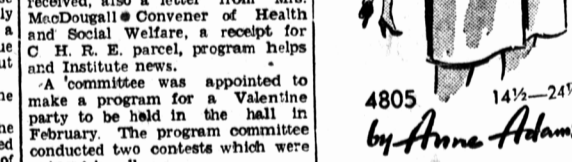
