Loafing Barn Is Completed

The "Loafing Barn" at the Experimental Farm, Upton has been completed and has been partially filled with between thirty and thirty five tons of hay. It was announced yesterday afternoon at the Junior Farmers Field Day.

The new type barn, 65 by 39 feet features a self feeding system which enables the cattle to eat as though they were eating from the side of a haystack. The animals will be provided with both chopped and long hay. It is expected that about twenty five young cattle will be housed in the barn this winter. There are no stalls or partitions in the building and the animals are free to move around at will.

A yard space will be paved behind the barn which will be surrounded with a high board fence so that the cattle may wander back and forth from the yard to the barn or vice versa without the danger of their becoming strayed. A silo has been built in the corner of the yard from which the cattle may obtain ensilage during the winter. Outside watering troughs electrically heated, will keep the cattle supplied with water for the year around.

Expect Agreement On Defence Orders

OTTAWA, Aug. 7. (CF) - Canada and the United States are expected to hammer out tomorrow the foundations of a new Hyde Park agreement under which the industrial might of both countries would be employed on a joint basis in the event of total war. Industrial mobilization planners of both countries will meet in the Senate railway committee room to put the final touches to a set of principles which, in effect, will have the same impact as that of the wartime Hyde Park agreement. Formal approval of these principles is expected to be announced at a later date by President Truman and Prime Minister St. Laurent. Their acceptance, it is indicated, will open the door to placement in Canada of American defence orders running into the hundreds of millions of dollars.

A Moot Question

"The question is what will happen to the scheme if because of illness or other misfortune beyond control of one or more of the tenants, rents cannot be collected. I don't know," said Mr. Stewart. "The idea of helping the needy is a good one as it might be said that with poor housing some of these people might be public charges for hospitalization. On the other hand it does not seem proper that deficits incurred under this scheme should be charged upon real estate which already carries the bulk of the load of municipal taxation. Anyway it is an interesting experiment and next year you may ask me how it is working."

Method of Financing

These buildings are financed under section 9 of the National Housing Act, said Mr. Stewart, as it provides that under certain conditions up to 90% of the money required will be advanced by the Government. The difference in the cost of the project amounting to about \$26,000 was voted by the Council. Because Central Mortgage and Housing Corporation will not do business with any municipal authority, the Owen Sound Housing Co. was formed, with five directors, at least three of whom must not be members of the municipal Council. Applicants are screened according to their need of housing, their respectability and their ability and willingness to pay. As the board of directors and not the Council controls the renting, political wirepulling to get apartments in eliminated.
