THE PUBLIC ACCOUNTS.

This report of the Committee on the Public Accounts was published in the last Islander, and is now a fair subject for newspaper comment. We must first observe that the published document, which is, no doubt, a correct copy of the Report agreed to by the Assembly, differs in several material points from the original draft that was signed by four members of the Committee.
