

Tax Exemptions For Ship Builders

OTTAWA (CP)—The principle of a bill amending the Canadian Income Tax Act, which provides for tax exemptions for ship owners and builders, was approved by the Commons Tuesday night.

Transport Minister George Drew, sponsor of a bill amending the Canadian Income Tax Act, said the measure is aimed at extending conditions under which assistance is given to ship owners and ship builders. The purpose of the measure was to encourage more shipbuilding in Canada in order to keep the industry alive in case of emergency.

One part of the bill would extend to Canadian-owned vessels and United Kingdom or other Commonwealth registry special accelerated depreciation allowances for tax purposes. This would allow Canadian shipowners, whose construction and operating expenses are higher than in the United Kingdom, to recover their capital outlays more quickly.

Another amendment would enable shipbuilders to obtain federal assistance on ships built on Canadian soil.

Still another provision would give shipbuilders freedom from seizure by the treasury, in case of the accelerated depreciation allowances.

Deer Hunters Were Fooled

CUMBERLAND, Md. (AP)—Four hunters from Baltimore approached a game warden Joseph Minko and asked whether they could check in a deer alive.

"I've never heard of it, but let's see him," replied Minko. The hunters went back into the woods. They waited an hour and then sent off his business.

Underground In Turkey Active

ANTOYA, Cyprus (Reuters)—A new underground "Turkish republic" organization has been formed in Cyprus to defend the interests of Cyprus' 90,000 Turkish minority, leaflets say.

The new organization, known as "THE P. S. YOLAN," a smaller Turkish underground organization which opposed union of the British island with Greece. The union movement has been backed by the Greek Cypriot and USA terrorist organizations.

The leaflets call every Turkish Cypriot to "stand by for our instructions." They advise "to remain calm and no indulge in any unlawful activity," as our "eyes in the United Nations is under the vigilance of the Turkish government."

To Be No. 2 Man In U. S. Justice

WASHINGTON (AP)—Canadian-born Lawrence E. Walsh, 45, a federal district judge for southern New York, was named Wednesday to be deputy United States attorney general.

President Eisenhower gave Walsh a recess appointment. A formal nomination will be sent to the senate when Congress reconvenes next month.

As No. 2 man in the justice department, Walsh succeeds William P. Rogers, who was sworn in as attorney general Nov. 4 to replace Herbert Brownell, who resigned.

Walsh was born in Port Matilda, Pa., and was brought to the U.S. in 1914. He became a naturalized U.S. citizen in 1922.

Test Skill At Pie Baking

TORONTO (CP)—Students from seven universities and school home economics departments in Ontario and Quebec will test their skills in the annual cherry pie bake-off Jan. 17. It was announced Tuesday.

The home economics staffs of each institution will choose a representative to represent each school in the final contest to be conducted here.

The best Canadian cherry pie bakers will then be sent to Chicago to compete Feb. 20 in the national contest. It will be the third successive year a Canadian will be matched against the best of U.S. cherry pie bakers—champions from each state, Alaska, and Hawaii.
