(GMa), 1 at Abram's Village on Dec. 2 (GMa), 1 at Rice Point on Dec. 6 (EMa), 1 immature between Middleton & Bedeque in plowed field on Dec. 10 (BH), 1 at Howe Bay/Eglington Bay on Dec. 10 to 12 (AMaK via GM), 1 in Charlottetown on Dec. 11 (DRe), 1 at Summerside on Dec. 11 (DA), 3 at Locke Shore Road area on Jan. 10 (LH, BM), 1 at North Cape and 1 at Summerside Airport in early winter as well as 5 others at various places (LH, BM), 1 at Mermaid on Jan. 13 (RG); **Barred Owl** - 1 at Indian River in a spruce tree on Nov. 26 (BG), 1 at Cavendish on Feb. 10 (FRC&DL); **Belted Kingfisher** - 1 at Nine Mile Creek & 1 at Cornwall on Jan. 10 (EMa), 1 at Crapaud on Jan. 13 (RA), 1 at Cymbria on Jan. 13 (EMa, DCS), 1 at New Glasgow on Jan. 24 (EMa); **Red-bellied Woodpecker** - male at Macphail's Homestead on Nov. 22 (EMa) & Nov. 24 (DCS); **Downy Woodpecker** - 1 at Sally Beach on Nov. 12 (PJ), male at Lakeside on Dec. 9 (DK, JB), 2 males & 2 females at Rocky Point suet feeder from Dec./01 to Jan./02 (LD), pair at Charlottetown feeder in Dec. & Jan. (SC), 4 at Crossroads feeder on Jan. 29 (DO); **Hairy Woodpecker** - 1 at China Point on Jan. 21 (DK), 3 at Crossroads feeder on Jan. 29 (DO); **Yellow-shafted (Northern) Flicker** - 1 at East Point on Nov. 10 (PJ), 2 at Rice Point on Dec. 6 (DCS), 2 at Lakeside on Dec. 9 (DK, JB), 1 at Monticello on Dec. 11 (GM), 1 at West Royalty on Dec. 16 (DCS), 2 at Lakeside on Dec. 18 (DK, JB, LM), 1 in Queens on Dec. 29 (DCS), 1 at New Glasgow suet feeder daily in Jan. (BHoa), 1 on Jan. 6 at Rice Point (EMa); **Pileated Woodpecker** - 1 at Caledonia woodlot in mid. Jan. (KMU via WmaK), 1 at Caledonia on Feb. 3 (JS); **Horned Lark** - 5 at Alexandria Point in field on Dec. 29 (DCS), 6 at Cavendish on Jan. 13 (EMa); **Western Kingbird** - between East Point and the beach to west on Nov. 12, good views of a tyrannus flycatcher with a pale gray head, small bill and yellow underparts were supplemented by excellent dorsal views of the bird as it hunted over the kelp and rockweed beds below the cliff, the white outer tail feathers on the black tail confirmed the identification (photo on file) (PJ); **Gray Jay** - 1 at Naufrage Pond on Nov. 10 (PJ), 1 on Jan. 1 at Iris (LB); **Blue Jay** - abundant in NE PEI from Nov. 10 to 13 (PJ), 20 to 25 daily at Rustico feeder in Dec. (KLC), lots at Lakeside on Dec. 9 (DK, JB), none seen at Tyne Valley feeder in quite a while on Jan. 31 (DMR), 12+ at Crossroads feeder on Jan. 29 (DO); **American Crow** - abundant in NE PEI from Nov. 10 to 13 (PJ), thousands on golf course and fields at Rocky point from mid to late Dec. (LD); **Common Raven** - common in NE PEI from Nov. 10 to 13 (PJ), 1 at Macphail Woods on Dec. 9 (DK, JB); **Horned Lark** - 30 to 40 at Locke Shore Road in Summerside in Jan. (LH), 13 at China Point on Jan. 21 (DK); **Northern Shrike** - 1 at Lakeside on Dec. 6 (DO); **Black-capped Chickadee** - common in NE PEI from Nov. 10 to 13 (PJ), 8 to 12 daily at Donagh feeder in Dec. & Jan. (JDM), 6 at Charlottetown feeder in Dec. Jan (SC), lots at Lakeside on Dec. 9 (DK, JB), 1 or 2 at North Winsloe feeder in Jan. (GP), 12+ at Crossroads feeder on Jan. 29 (DO); **Boreal Chickadee** - common in NE PEI from Nov. 10 to 13 (PJ); **Red-breasted Nuthatch** - 2 at PEI National Park on Nov. 11 & 3 at Sally Beach on Nov. 12 (PJ), 4 at Macphails Woods on Nov. 24 (DCS), 1 or 2 at Donagh feeder in late Nov. to Feb. (JDM), 1 at Lakeside on Dec. 9 (DK, JB), 4 on Dec. 26 at Rustico feeder (KLC), 2 at Charlottetown feeder in Dec. & early Jan (SC), 1 at Enmore feeder on Jan. 1 (GP), 3 at Crossroads feeder on Jan. 29 (DO); **White-breasted Nuthatch** - female at New Dominion on Nov. 21 & Dec. 1 (DCS), 1 regularly at New Dominion feeder in Dec. & Jan. (EMa); **Brown Creeper** - almost daily at Rocky Point feeder from Dec./01 to Jan./02 (LD), first in a few years at Crossroads Feeder on Jan. 9 & Jan. 29 (DO); **American Robin** - uncommon in NE PEI with maximum daily count of 6 from Nov. 10 to 13 (PJ), 1 at North Rustico on Dec. 30 (DCS), 4 at Rocky Point feeder on Jan. 6 (LD), 1 near Flat River on Jan. 7 (DK, JB, LM, SC), 9 at Oyster Bed Bridge on Jan. 13 (EMa), 1 at Nine Mile Creek on Jan. 24 (EMa);
