The space-age stocks toppled to losses running to 8 points or more. The key stocks which govern the market averages dropped fractions to around 4 points. Think of, the week's most active issue, dropped 7 1/2 points of the 18 1/2 it had gained in the three previous sessions this week. The Associated Press 60-stock average fell \$2.90 to \$224. The Dow Jones industrial average fell 8.75 to 615.64. Joining in the decline were utilities, steels, rails, non-ferrous metals, rubbers, chemicals, oils and tobaccos. Motors were mixed. Canadian issues joined the down trend. International Nickel lost 1/4. Walker Gooderham 1/2, Canadian Pacific 1/2, Aluminium Ltd., and Hudson Bay Mining 1/2 and Distillers Seagrams 1/2.
