POTATO GROWERS and SHIPPERS
This is to advise Potato Growers and Shippers that Board Order A-2, issued by the Potato Board on the 20th of January, 1964 is to be strict adhered to during the present shipping season. The Order is as follows:

1. Effective forthwith no dealer or other person shall ship potatoes from Prince Edward Island in 100 pound sacks, 75 pound sacks, or 50 pound sacks without showing the grower's identification number, such number to be clearly stamped on the identification tag attached to the sack and shall be the registration number assigned to the grower by the Potato Board.

2. A dealer or grower, shipping potatoes from Prince Edward Island by railway car, shall attach thereto, on the inside of the car, a proper loading manifest showing the number of bags and identification number of each lot therein.
