

Monster Icebergs on The Atlantic.

The gigantic Arctic icebergs reported yesterday by our correspondent at St. Johns Nfld., as blocking that harbor, are large enough to rival the celebrated Antarctic bergs.

THE IMMENSE GLACIAL MASSES;

now observed off St. John's, instead of being conspicuous for their height, are of the "tabular" or Antarctic type. At this season icebergs off Newfoundland are becoming very fragile, and that probably before reaching the latitude of St. John's these bergs were much larger than they now appear.

WILL DISGORGE THEIR ICE DRIFT and be less difficult of navigation than they generally are in August and September. Meantime the appearance of these huge bergs bearing down on the main highways of Atlantic commerce should be a warning to navigators that the ice season of 1884, which began at an unusually early date, is by no means over.
