**Shell To Hunt Gas And Oil Off N.S. Coast**

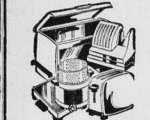
OTTAWA (CP) — Shell Canada Limited has applied for federal permits to hunt gas and oil under a 20,000,000-acre area of the Atlantic Ocean off the Nova Scotia coast. It was announced Friday.

Resources Minister Laing said in a statement that the Shell application proposes expenditure of \$1,000,000 a year for three years on exploration. The application would be processed immediately.

The exploratory area is roughly 100 miles wide by 450 miles long and runs parallel to Nova Scotia's long coastline facing southeast into the Atlantic.

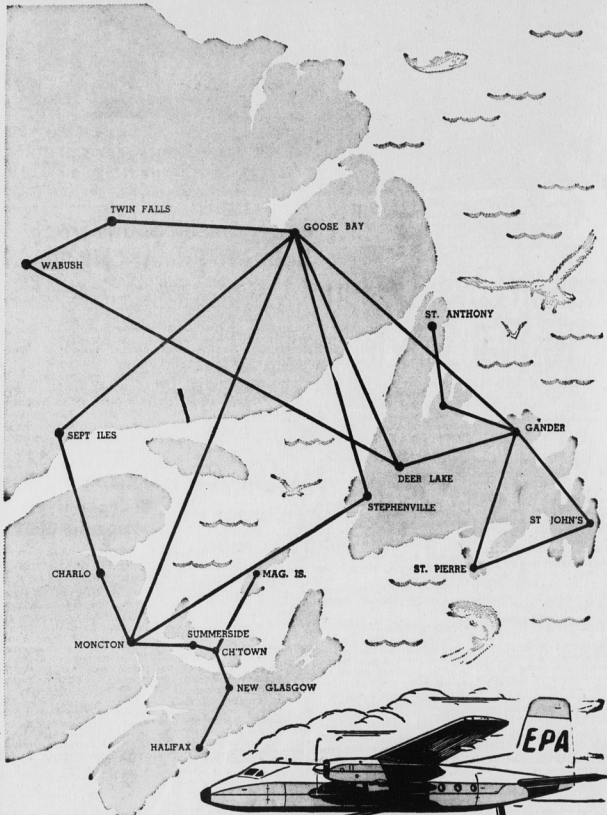
It surrounds a 1,000,000-acre exploratory region leased to Socomey Mobil Oil of Canada Limited in July, 1960. The Socomey region, centred around Sable Island, has been under active exploration.

small vice-president said in a statement the company plans to conduct a reconnaissance seismic program in the area as a first step. "It is not anticipated that Shell's exploratory efforts or any drilling operations to which these might eventually lead will interfere with the use of the offshore waters for other purposes," he said. Shell spokesmen did not release the initial cost of the program. Helium was discovered in the sun's chromosphere in 1902, almost 30 years before its identification as an element on earth.
